

CLERK'S REPORT - Full Council meeting - 26th November 2018

Calendars for website

At the Full Council meeting on 29th October 2018, the Clerk was asked to ascertain the cost of setting up an online booking system so that rooms could be booked directly from the website and also enquire regarding online version of other forms (eg Allotment booking form etc). 2Commune has advised that they don't offer a complete booking system where members of the public can book appointments directly into a calendar. Therefore, the Clerk is exploring the inclusion on the website of two calendars, which would be populated by the Parish Office staff, to show room bookings at a cost of £100 as noted at the meeting on 29th October 2018.

MUGA lights

At the Full Council meeting on 29th October 2018, the Clerk was asked to check whether the time at which the MUGA is lit is set out as a condition of its planning consent and, if not, see if it might be possible to extend the hours. The Clerk has spoken to Cllr Reid regarding this issue who has indicated that he feels that 9.30 pm is an appropriate time to turn off the lights to encourage young people not to congregate later in the evening and to due to possible light pollution of neighbouring properties. Cllr Reid has said he is happy to speak to other Councillors about this issue.

Parish Office opening hours over Christmas and New Year

In discussion with Cllr Williams, it has been agreed that the Parish Office will be closed from Monday, 24th December 2018 to Tuesday, 1st January 2019 inclusive. (This period includes Public Holidays on 25th and 26th December 2018 and 1st January 2019).
