**CK Health Connections - Social prescribing project** The Parish Council has been successful in its bid for a £5,000 grant, facilitated by County Councillors Babbage and Sudbury, from the Gloucestershire County Council "Growing our Communities Fund" towards the initial six-month phase of a project that will connect local people with services that will support their health and well-being. We will shortly be advertising the self-employed role of Community Development Worker to undertake this work. For more information contact the Parish Office.

**Bus Shelters – cleaning and replacement** All the Bus Shelters that belong to the Parish Council have recently been thoroughly cleaned. We have also replaced the damaged Bus Shelter on Little Herbert's Road.
